Diver Prerequisites

- Be at least 12 years old for Jr Open Water or 15 years old for Open Water.
 - 10 and 11 year olds may be certified as Jr Open Water divers (via a private course for an additional fee of \$295).
- Ability to float/tread for 10 minutes and able to swim continuously for 200 yards (any style) or 300 yards with mask, fins and snorkel.
- Complete a Diver Medical Form without any precluding conditions or have a Diver Medical Form signed and approved by a physician.

Equipment

- Each student must supply their own scuba quality mask, snorkel, fins, boots & inflatable signal tube (or DSMB).
- BCD, regulators, tanks, weights & wetsuit will be supplied by New Wave for Training.

Terms, Conditions and Enrollment Requirements:

1. When signing up for eLearning on PADI.com diver must associate with **New Wave Snorkel and Scuba Center LLC**. or an additional charge of \$125 will be added to Fees
2. Attend an orientation session were you will be asked to:
 - a. Complete release forms for the PADI Open Water Diver Course.
 - b. Complete a Diver medical Form. This information is confidential and, because it identifies medical conditions that may be affected by diving, it is vital that you are complete and accurate. If any of the conditions apply to you, you will need to consult with a physician and receive written clearance before any in water training. If you require a physician's approval for diving, you may print the diver medical form complete it and take it to your physician for approval. Then bring it back to the dive center before any in water training.
 - c. Size the equipment to you.
 - d. If you did not purchase your mask, snorkel, fins, boots and DSMB from New Wave Scuba please present them to be approved by the instructor for use during the course.
3. After completing e-learning schedule and attend an academic review session were you will be asked to:
 - a. Complete a 25 question multiple choice written exam.
 - b. Review the operation of the dive computer that you will use in pool and open water sessions.
4. Students are responsible for picking up and returning scuba equipment for open water sessions.
 - a. Scuba equipment is to be picked up one to two days before open water session.
 - b. Scuba equipment shall be returned cleaned one to two days after the open water session.
5. Junior Diver Certifications
 - a. For 10 and 11 year olds, the parent/guardian and child must view the Youth Risk Management DVD (or review the Youth Diving: Responsibility and Risks Flipchart). Read and sign Youth Diving: Responsibility and Risks Acknowledgment form before the course.
 - b. After certification, 10 to 11 year olds are restricted to diving with a parent, guardian or PADI Professional to 40 feet maximum depth; 12 to 14 year olds must dive with an adult certified diver.
 - c. 10 and 11 year olds must take the Open Water as a private course, due to reduced instructor student ratios. The additional fee for a private course is \$295.
6. Payment is required at time of enrollment for each section of the course.
7. Must complete academics as directed by the instructor prior to attending each session.
8. Enrollment closes 3 days prior to start of class.
9. All paperwork and class requirements must be completed prior to start of first class.
10. Fees are fully earned upon start of class; there are no refunds on unused portions.
11. Failure to attend (no-show) your scheduled class or requesting a refund less than 96 hours before class starts results in No Refund.
12. Full Course Refund minus \$25 Administrative Fee, if requested 96 hours before start of class.
 - a. Academic Materials and e-learning are not refundable and will be subtracted from any refund.
13. Certification is not guaranteed you must complete all academics and skills to a level of mastery as determined by your instructor. If you are not able to complete a skill to a level of mastery during your academic, pool or open water sessions one additional session will be offered to you at no additional charge. If you need additional sessions they will be offered for an additional charge of \$75.
 - a. All PADI quizzes and exams require a 75% or better grade for certification.
 - i. For those that are not successful in their first attempt at a quiz or exam an instructor will review the missed question with the student and administer another exam or quiz.
14. Academic and pool training valid for 1 year.
15. If it is more than 3 months between pool and open water training with New Wave than one pool refresher maybe required at no charge prior to open water with New Wave. Additional refreshers are \$50 each. 6 months to a year since training the required refresher will be \$75 and a quiz may be required. Longer than 12 months and you will need to retake the entire course at full price.
